

## Quality, Environmental, and Occupational Health & Safety (OH&S) Policy

The Quality, Environmental, and Occupational Health & Safety (OH&S) Policy of EVENT PLUS is defined in accordance with the requirements of its clients, the applicable legislation, and its business principles.

The approach of EVENT PLUS concerning Quality, Environmental, and OH&S Management is expressed through the Company's Integrated Management System (IMS), which serves as a framework for the continuous improvement of service quality, environmental performance, and workplace safety.

- Continuous training and education of personnel on Quality, Environmental, and OH&S topics, ensuring competence and awareness.
- Investigating the causes of non-conformities, complaints, accidents, or near misses and defining corrective actions as the primary mechanism for continuous improvement.
- Raising awareness among all employees regarding Environmental Management and Environmental Protection issues, minimizing environmental impacts, and preventing pollution.
- Promoting a safe and responsible work culture, ensuring the use of appropriate Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) where required, and complying with OH&S procedures.
- Communicating Quality, Environmental, and OH&S performance data to relevant bodies, partners, and the community upon request.
- Providing the necessary resources, equipment, and infrastructure for the effective implementation of the Integrated Management System, ensuring Quality, Environmental, and OH&S Objectives & Goals are met.
- Ensuring full compliance with all applicable Quality, Environmental, and OH&S legal and regulatory requirements.
- Monitoring and measuring Significant Environmental Aspects, OH&S risks, and Key Performance Indicators (KPIs) to improve the Company's overall performance and sustainability.
